THE GOSPELS OF THE NEW TESTAMENT

Paul's Gospel of Completion

- 1. Paul combines all aspects of the first four gospel
- 2. Paul proceeds to unveil an unsearchably rich Christ and His effect on us
- 3. Paul reveals Christ or His work in the following ways:
 - Christ in us, the hope of glory (Col.1:27)
 - The Spirit of Christ is a seal and pledge (Eph.1:13-14)
 - Christ, the Last Adam, has become the Life-giving Spirit (1Cor.15:45)
 - Being filled unto all the fullness of God. (Eph.3:19)
 - Christ is the mystery of God (Col.2:2)
 - The church is the mystery of Christ (Eph.3:4)
 - God has an eternal purpose in Christ Jesus our Lord (Eph.1:9, 3:11)
 - God has an economy or plan to carry out His purpose (Eph.1:10, 3:2, 9; 1Tim.1:4, Col.1:25; 1Cor.9:17)
 - Other items include Christ has a Body, He is the head of that Body, we are members of that Body, we are the One New Man, Living is Christ, Bountiful Supply of the Spirit; the unsearchable riches of Christ, a treasure...
- 4. In Galatians alone Paul reveals Christ and His work, this way:
 - God was pleased to reveal His Son in Paul (1:15-16)
 - Christ living in us (2:20)
 - Christ being formed in us (4:19)
 - The law of Christ (6:2)
 - The cross of Christ (6:14)
 - The new creation (6:15)
 - The brands of Jesus (6:17)
 - The grace of Christ (6:18)

PAUL'S GOSPEL

- 1. The Gospel of Grace (John 1:17, 1Cor.15:10, Gal.2:20)
- 2. The Unique Gospel
 - a. Gospels that are not The Gospel and their messengers accursed (vv.7-9)
 - b. Not According to, Not Received from, & Not Taught by Man (vv.11-12)
- 3. Received through the Revelation of Jesus Christ (v.12)
 - a. Realizing Christ as Lord on road to Damascus (Act 9:3-5)
 - b. Realizing Chris has a Body (Acts 9:4, 6, 17, 19, 25, 27-28)
 - c. Realizing the Body is not limited to Jews (Acts11:18-20, 25-26)
- 4. Preaching the Gospel as a Slave of Christ (Ga.1:10)
 - a. Not pleasing men
 - b. Pleasing God
